Ruby Hale Field lived to be 100 and during those 100 years she accomplished enough to fill many lifetimes. Born in San Jose, CA, she earned a degree in English and Journalism at Stanford University before her marriage to Oliver C. Field. The couple was among the earliest residents of Palos Verdes Estates, California.

Ruby devoted her fortune and her energy to financing library institutions, becoming the first person we know of to make a planned gift through her estate to the Palos Verdes Library District. The guiding principle of her life as she would tell it is, "keep busy and contribute in every way as much as you can." She was a delightful lady with sparkling blue eyes, a keen wit, a lively imagination and a commitment to the future of the Library.

Ruby knew the importance of planning for the future. By her actions, she provided a legacy that is still strong today.
